

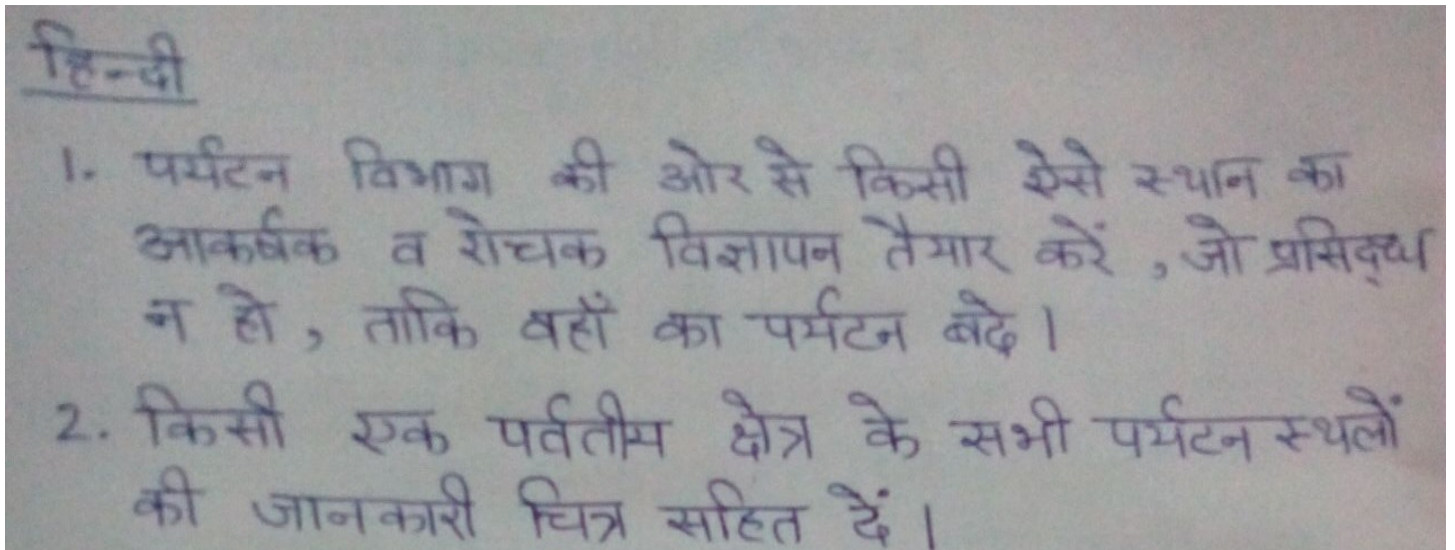

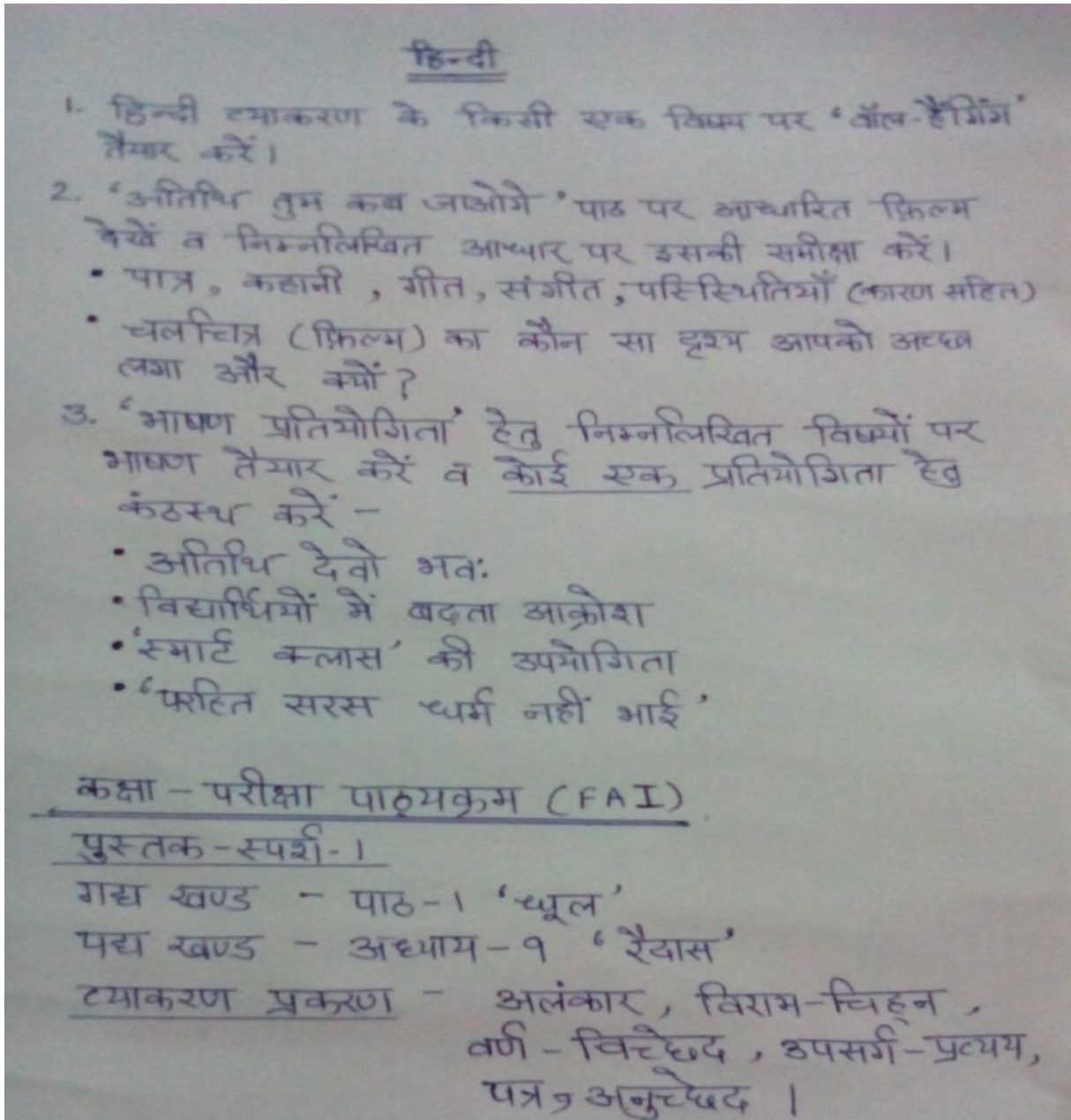
ENGLISH
